The Council strongly objects to this development. In addition to previous comments and to reiterate:

- The development is in close proximity to commercial and employment land with no buffer/separation or sound attenuation. There are no limits on what could take place at the neighbouring site.
- The access on to Shipdham Road is unacceptable, given the number of properties accessing the is a significant risk of vehicles needing to reverse onto Shipdham Road after meeting a vehicle exiting.
- There is no designated space for wheelie bins, at the entrance with Shipdham Road, these are likely to reduce visibility and obstruct the pavements.
- There is no designated parking space for visitors
- There is no swept path analysis to demonstrate that emergency vehicles can access the site turn and exit in forward gear.
- There would be an amenity impact on neighbour properties with vehicle lights.
- There area was highlighted as an area with flooding issues in the 2016 Flood Investigation Report.
