1. To receive apologies for absence.

There were no apologies for absence.

2. Declaration of Interest.

Councillor H Clarke declared a non-pecuniary interest in item 3 as he is a member of 'Dementia Friendly Dereham'.

3. To consider contributing funding towards Breckland Council's refurbishment of the Queen Mother's Garden.

The committee agreed that this item should be put on hold until more information had been received from Breckland Council.

4. To discuss Commemorative Citizens award for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

The committee recommended that the Town Council purchase 30 medals for the Jubilee citizens award, which would be specially minted at a cost of approximately £600.

The committee recommended that there should not be a specific criteria for the Citizens award, each submission would be judged on the impact that the person volunteering has had on the community and environment.

5. To consider a policy for only approved stonemason to erect memorials in Dereham cemeteries.

The committee recommended that Town Council have a policy that only approved stonemasons erect memorials in Dereham cemeteries.

The committee recommended that to be an approved stonemason for Dereham Town Council the stonemason would be required to have a professional qualification or membership of a professional body and who agree to abide by the Town Council rules and that all memorials comply with the current British Standard.
