Traffic Management Meeting 26th October 2021

The following items have been forward for the Parish Partnership Scheme.

- Zebra Crossing on Quebec Road. This would be near the gate to Northgate High School playing field. NCC confirmed in early 2021 that the 20mph advisory part time speed limit has suppressed speeds sufficiently to make a Zebra Crossing viable. Northgate High School have been keen to have a Zebra Crossing installed for more than 4 years. The approximate cost is £72,000. If the Town Council submitted a maximum bid for £50,000, the remaining funding required may potentially be drawn from the Local Member Highway Budget, the Community Road Safety Fund or Department for Transport funding.
- Norwich Road Bus Shelter – near the access to Union Drift/almost opposite Cherry Lane. With the Greenfields Road development well underway and this bus stop nearly opposite Cherry Lane, passenger numbers at this bus stop will increase in future years. The pavement near the bus stop on the south side of Norwich Road in this area is too narrow for a bus shelter. The bus stops on Norwich Road are served by First Group and Konect Bus. Any new bus shelter would be owned and maintained by the Town Council. Approximate cost – £3,250 for a 2 bay bus shelter.
- New footway/trod between the new cemetery entrance and Etling Green. This has been proposed by Dereham Footpath Warden Ken Hawkins. The trod would be alongside the B1147 road. A footway would make the highway safer for residents of Etling Green to access the town via Norwich Road and for walkers seeking to access countryside to the north east of Dereham. The trod would look like the one on Northgate between the hospital entrance and the junction for Northall Green. Approximate cost – awaiting feedback from NCC Highways. The cost would be under the £50,000 limit per bid.
