3. To consider details of additional roll of honour at the Memorial Hall.

Dereham Town Council is custodian of two war memorials, the cenotaph in the town center, erected at the end of the 1st World War and the Memorial Hall purchased after the 2nd World War. In recent years three additional names have been added to the Cenotaph these were:

Hendry - died – 2011

Wormald - died – 1952

Clitheroe – died - 1916

In 2019 the Council agreed that a new memorial be erected in the Memorial Hall because the existing stones at the entrance, could not accommodate additional inscriptions. The principle in preparing the new memorial is that it should not be seen that this additional memorial has any greater or lesser significance than the existing stones. To this extent a similar stone has been chosen and the lettering will be the same size and style. There will be one obvious difference that this stone will be on the inside of the building while the other stones are on the outside, but there is not much that can be about that.

The proposal is to have a plaque in landscape form with words at the top with the words:

*“At the going down of the sun and in the morning,
We will remember them”*
