At a virtual extraordinary meeting of the **Finance & Governance Committee** held on **Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2021** upon the rising of the extraordinary Recreation Committee meeting.

- 1. **To receive apologies for absence.** There were no apologies for absence
- 2. **Declaration of Interest.** There were no declarations of interest.
- 3. To discuss, in principle, the financial options available for purchasing additional land around the Neatherd.

Two options to consider.

- 1) Take out a loan over 50 years this would add £3 a year to a band D council tax bill.
- 2) Pool funds allocated to other projects this would mean other projects would not be delivered.

Councillors discussed the options with Councillor L Monument suggesting a third option of part pooling and part loan.

## 4. Exclusion of press and public.

Proposed by Councillor T Monument, seconded by Councillor H Clarke it was agreed to pass a resolution to exclude the Press and Public from the meeting on the grounds that the Business to be transacted is confidential and publicity would be prejudicial to the public interest.

## 5. To discuss in detail the financial options for purchasing additional land around the Neatherd.
