



Norwich Road Cemetery Memorial Guidance

Temporary vases must be placed as close to the headstone as possible. This is to avoid obstructing grass cutting. Any vase not left by the headstone may be removed.

If the grave does not have a headstone, the temporary vase should be placed in line with neighbouring headstones.

Both the flowers and the vase are regarded as temporary.

Once the flowers have died, both the flowers and the vase will be disposed of without notice. In the case of silk flowers, these will be removed once they have faded or become unsightly.

The Town Council does not accept any liability should a temporary vase become damaged during maintenance of the cemetery.

Any empty temporary vase left on a grave will be disposed of by the Council.

Not Allowed

- Solar lights, including ornaments incorporating solar lights
- Clothing
- Windmills
- Ornaments, cards, photographs and pot plants remain unauthorised and unacceptable unless they will fit (without overhanging) onto the plinth of the headstone
- For safety reasons, **any glass or china must not be brought into the cemetery and will be removed without notice**
