During the allotment inspections officers will check that the hens are suitably housed and being well cared for, if they are not happy that this is the case, permission can be revoked.

The Town Council will pass on your contact details to the RSPCA if requested to do so.

As of October 2024 all poultry keepers are legally required to register their flocks with the Government, and update this information annually, regardless of the size (this includes backyard and allotment poultry keepers). Please ensure that your flock is registered immediately. Visit Gov.uk for more information.
