1. <u>To consider apologies for absence.</u>

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor A Brooks.

2. **Declaration of Interest.**

There were no declarations of interest.

3. <u>To consider proposals for the Parish Partnership Scheme – 2022/23.</u>

The committee recommended the following proposals for the Parish Partnership Scheme – 2022/23:

- Zebra Crossing on Quebec Road, near to the gate to Northgate High School £72,000.
- A two-bay bus shelter on Norwich Road near the access to Union Drift - £3250.

There was a further suggestion of a new footway/trod between the entrance to the new cemetery and Etling Green but the committee agreed that this should be deferred until next year's Parish Partnership Scheme.

Councillor C Bunting reminded the meeting that he had requested at a previous meeting for a speed survey to be carried out on Stone Road. The Deputy Town Clerk said that she would arrange for the SAM 2 sign (speed awareness message) to be moved to Stone Road, these signs record information about the number of times the signs are activated, along with the time. Data about the traffic volume is also recorded.
